Do You Need the Support of a Good Officer?


Are you experiencing communication problems with your board or your minister?

RENEWING YOUR AUUA MEMBERSHIP

A few reminders about membership:

- Membership is open to all administrators serving Unitarian Universalist congregations. (Not all AUUA members are Unitarian Universalist or a member of a UU congregation.) You need to renew your membership annually; see info below about how to renew.
- Additional administrative staff within your church, regional office, or UUA department receive a 50% discount off their AUUA membership fee after one fully paid AUUA membership – this discount is available for up to five additional staff members. If you have staff that you feel would benefit from their own membership in the AUUA, please contact MaryBeth Hannan, <u>churchoffice@kentuu.org</u>, who will provide you with a discount coupon code to use during registration of additional staff members.

Renew and stay connected to a great group of peers!

How to renew:

- 1. Visit www.auua.org and log in
 - a. It's important that you are logged into the website so your information will update in our database
 - b. If you do not remember your log in credentials, contact <u>MaryBeth Hannan</u> to request a new password.
- 2. How you renew depends on whether your membership is current or has expired.
 - a. If your membership is still current
 - i. Click the "Members" drop down, then "Renew Membership," and
 - ii. Choose your congregation size to complete
 - b. If your membership is expired
 - i. Click the "Join Us!" drop down, and
 - ii. Choose your congregation size to complete
- 3. Payment for your membership dues can be made:
 - a. Via PayPal by logging into your PayPal account, or
 - b. Via PayPal as a guest (no need to log in) and paying with a credit or debit card, or
 - c. By check made payable to AUUA, <u>including your name</u> on the memo line, and mailed to: AUUA c/o MaryBeth Hannan, UU Church of Kent, 228 Gougler Avenue, Kent, OH 44240.
